
## Piece by Piece Pineapple Pattern

### Pineapple Top



After you have finished piecing the top,

you will need to add background fabric around the pieced top.

Cut one 3.5 inch square and one 5 inch square. Cut each square in half on the diagonal. Stitch the bottom 3.5 inch triangles on first.

Then stitch the 5 inch triangles on the top one side at a time.




## Piece by Piece Pineapple Pattern


#### Pineapple Bottom

To make Half Square Triangles (HST) place squares right sides together. Draw line on wrong side of top square and stitch 1/4 inch on each side of the drawn line. Cut along drawn line and press seams open.

Repeat with one HST square and one solid square for combined HST. Make sure to draw line and stitch perpendicular to original HST.



Cut 10 assorted dark yellow (dk) squares = 2.5 inch Cut 6 assorted light yellow (lt) squares = 2.5 inch Cut 5 background (bkgd) squares = 2.5 inch





## Piece by Piece Pineapple Pattern

# Pineapple Bottom continued

Layout your finised pieces and stitch the body of the pineapple in diagonal rows including the 2 small bkgd squares. Stitch the bottom 5 inch bkgd triangles to the pineapple body first. Then stitch the top 3 inch bkgd triangles to the pineapple body.
